## Parking and School Traffic

We hope that the first half term is going well and that your children have settled happily into school routines. The safety of the children in our care is of paramount importance. As we move into autumn and visibility starts to reduce, please may we draw your attention to key safety reminders regarding car transport and parking.

- The speed limit for all roads onto the College and Prep School site is 10mph. Please adhere to this limit.
- All visitors are expected to drive sensibly and with due care and attention to their surroundings. The main Wymondham College Reception car park gets particularly busy between 8:00am – 9:00am and 3:00pm – 4:00pm. If you have children in Yr 7 and older years, please park nearest the House of the older sibling at either the Kett, Lincoln or Cavell car parks. We kindly request that parents / carers do not congregate in groups within the car parks creating further congestion.
- There are 3 drop off zones located across the College car parks – 2 in Cavell car park and 1 at the Reception car park. These are designed to enable car to pull into them and for passengers to jump out with their belongings in hand. They should not be used as parking spaces.
- Please avoid mounting or parking on verges or along roads.
- WCPS parents, please where possible continue to park in your allocated zone - see the map attached.
- Where possible, we recommend that parents use the B1172 London Road to drop off and collect their children as this road is wider and more free flowing than the narrower route through Morley village. Out of respect of the residents of Morley Village and its community, please avoid driving to and from our campus via the village route.

We very much appreciate your support in keeping the site, and surrounding environment as safe and uncongested as possible.
