#### FLEXI BOARDING IN UNDERWOOD HALL

We are now offering 'flexi-boarding' to day pupils in Years 5 or Year 6 allowing them the opportunity to board on a flexible basis. The cost of flexi-boarding is £100 per night and will include the cost of dinner, breakfast and accommodation in Underwood Hall. There is also a booking fee of £30 the first time a booking is made.

If you wish to book for your child to flexi board then please click on the link below. Alternatively you can email the school office or Mr. Timmins who is the Head of Underwood Hall. They will then be in touch with you with further information which will include instructions on how payment is to be made.

Bags should be dropped off at 8:30am on the day. At 4:00pm, your child will do their home learning and at 4:45pm will return to Underwood Hall where they will join in with the boarding routines and activities for the remainder of that day. The following morning, they will have breakfast and then embark upon their normal working day having hopefully got some sleep! There will be an annual limit of 45 nights' accommodation per pupil per academic year. #### Reception Rabbits & Robins

We have continued the Harvest theme this week and have had great fun making harvest wreaths, making fruit and vegetables out of playdough, creating leaf rubbings, drawing fruit and vegetables and learning more about what happens at harvest. In Phonics we have learnt our next 4 sounds (q o c k) and our first tricky word 'is'. These will all be in your packs. In English we started a new unit based on the book 'On Sudden Hill'. In Maths we have been learning about 'size' including smaller/taller, heavier/lighter and also capacity. We had great fun with the instruments in Music this week and were practicing 'sidestepping' in PE. See if your child can remember how they might be feeling if they are in the 'yellow zone'.





#### Year 1 Otters & Seals

This week in Year 1 we have been learning some new phonics sounds (phase 5)! Please see the sheet in your child's reading log which shares the sounds and tricky words for the week - do practise these at home. The teachers have been so impressed with the children's efforts in their independent writing this week as part of English. In maths, we have been comparing amounts and looking at part whole models (with numbers up to 10). In georgprahy we learned about the United Kingdom and enjoyed locating the different countries within it on a map. We discussed drawing from observation in art, using our careful looking eyes to sketch what we can see, rather than our imagintions. In Computing we explored the keyboard.

#### Year 2 Badgers & Foxes

In Year 2 this week, we have enjoyed celebrating Heritage Day and learning more about one another's backgrounds and traditions. We also had our school photographs taken and carried out a science investigation to test the absorbency of different materials. In maths, we explored adding to the next 10, using our number knowledge to solve problems efficiently. The children have also begun preparing for their first piece of independent writing of the year and are full of exciting ideas!





#### Year 3 Dragonflies & Bumblebees

Year 3 have had a wonderful week of learning and adventure! We loved celebrating Heritage Day and especially enjoyed visiting Wymondham College for a fascinating heritage tour. It was amazing to look at old photos and discover how the college land was used in the past. In maths, we've been adding and subtracting tens from three-digit numbers and growing in confidence with our number work. Our most exciting event this week was a surprise visit from the Incredible Book Eating Boy! He left a huge mess in our classroom, and the children became brilliant detectives to solve the mystery! This was a great way to start our English unit - we can't wait to see what happens next!
